Aurora Avenue North Multimodal Corridor Project
Interurban Trail Pedestrian and Bicycle Crossing

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by Shoreline City Clerk's Office at Shoreline City Hall, 17544 Midvale Avenue North, Suite 100, Shoreline, Washington, 98133-4921. Bids are due no later than 1:00 PM, EXACTLY, Pacific local time, according to the clock in the City's Clerk's Office, May 3, 2005, at the time and date above stated, the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A pre-bid meeting and job site tour with the City, the construction management team and design consultant will be held on April 18th, 2005 at 1:30 PM, Room 305, City Hall for the purpose of briefing the project particulars and responding to questions and clarifying issues and concerns with the project. These responses shall be included in a future addenda issued by the City.

Proposals are to be submitted only on the forms provided with this Project Manual. Accompany each bid with a certified check, cashier's check, or surety company bid bond, on a form acceptable to the City, from State-licensed surety company as surety, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the bid amount, payable to the "City of Shoreline." A one hundred percent (100%) Contract Bond must be submitted by the successful low bidder with the bid package. Incomplete proposals and proposals received after the time fixed for the opening will not be considered. Faxed responses are not acceptable.

The work consists of furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials necessary to complete the project referenced above. The work shall include, but not limited to, the improvement of Aurora Avenue North from just south of N. 145th St to just north of N 165th St. by reconstructing the existing 4 lane roadway to a 6 lane roadway together with a center median/turn lane, landscaped amenity zone with pedestrian facilities. Improvements will also be constructed on N 152nd St, N 155th St and N 165th St. Work also includes the construction of pedestrian and bicycle bridges over N 155th St (west of Aurora) and over Aurora Avenue North (just south of the Westminster Way and Aurora Avenue North intersection) Work contemplated to be performed under this contract is as follows:

Removal and replacement of existing asphalt roadway, removal and replace of concrete sidewalks, drainage improvements, illumination, signalization, utility trenching and related work for utility underground conversion to include individual services, irrigation, landscape, installation of other urban design improvements, work to restore access to adjacent private properties and other work.

The estimated construction cost for the base bid plus all alternative schedules is between \$19.0M and \$22.0M.

The time for completion for the work on the site is 360 working days.

All bidding shall be based upon compliance with the Contract Plans and the Contract Provisions. Division 1 APWA Supplement of the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) Standard Specifications 2004 will apply to this contract.

Substitutions will not be accepted during the bid process.

All bidders must certify that they are not on the Controller General's list of ineligible contractors nor on the list of parties excluded from Federal procurement or non-procurement programs.

No bidder may withdraw their bid within SIXTY (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Bid documents for this project will be available for viewing after 2:00 PM on Monday, April 4, 2005 at the Shoreline City Hall Annex. City Hall Annex is located in Suite 107 at 1110 N. 175th St.

Bidders must register to be notified of addendum and new documents on this project. It is the bidder's responsibility to check for addenda and other new documents on-line.

Bidders shall submit questions no later than 1:00 PM, Thursday, April 28, 2005. Where a response or addendum from the City can not be obtained prior to the bid opening, it is understood that the Bidder has made provisions for a more costly method before submitting the bid. Where conflicts or omissions occur in Plans, Specifications, or other related Contract Documents (such as manufacturer's instructions, reference standards, and regulatory agencies and codes), Bidder shall assume more stringent requirements and verify with the City before beginning work. Questions via phone will not be accepted.

The DBE goals assigned as part of this contract are 12% and a Training Goal of 2000 hours.
