

**CALL FOR BIDS**  
**North City Project**

**Bids Due: July 1, 2004 1:00 PM**

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by Shoreline City Clerk's Office at Shoreline City Hall, 17544 Midvale Avenue North, Suite 100, Shoreline, Washington, 98133-4921. Bids are due no later than 1:00 PM, EXACTLY, Pacific local time, according to the clock in the City's Clerk's Office, July 1, 2004, for the project hereinafter referred to as:

**North City Project**

At the time and date above stated, the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud. Proposals are to be submitted only on the forms provided with this Project Manual. Accompany each bid with a certified check, cashier's check, or surety company bid bond, on a form acceptable to the City, from State-licensed surety company as surety, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the bid amount, payable to the "City of Shoreline." A one hundred percent (100%) Contract Bond must be submitted by the successful low bidder and a one-year warranty bond will be required upon final completion. Incomplete proposals and proposals received after the time fixed for the opening will not be considered. Faxed responses are not acceptable.

The work consists of furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials necessary to complete the project referenced above. The work shall include, but not limited to, the improvement of 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE from approximately NE 172<sup>nd</sup> to NE 180<sup>th</sup> by reconstructing the existing 4 lane roadway to a 3 lane roadway with improved on street parking and pedestrian facilities. Work contemplated to be performed under this contract is as follows:

Removal and replacement of existing asphalt roadway, removal and replace of concrete sidewalks, drainage improvements, illumination, signal, utility trenching and related work to utility undergrounding conversion, irrigation, landscape, installation of other urban design improvements, work to restore access to adjacent private properties and other work.

The estimated construction cost is between \$4.6M and \$5.0M.

The time for completion for the work on the site is 240 working days.

All bidding shall be based upon compliance with the Contact Plans and the Contract Provisions. Division 1 APWA Supplement of the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) Standard Specifications 2004 will apply to this contract. Substitutions will not be accepted during the bid process.

All bidders must certify that they are not on the Controller General's list of ineligible contractors nor on the list of parties excluded from Federal procurement or non-procurement programs.

No bidder may withdraw their bid within SIXTY (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Half-sized bid documents for this project will be available for viewing and purchase after 2:00 PM on Monday, June 14, 2004 at the Shoreline City Hall Annex and may be obtained from the Public Works Department for \$100 (non-refundable). **Payment must be in the form of a cashier's check only** made payable to the City of Shoreline. City Hall Annex is located in Suite 107 at 1110 N. 175<sup>th</sup> St. Bid documents will be mailed at an additional cost of \$10. Payment must be received prior to delivery of bid documents. Full-sized bid documents will be on file by June 17, 2004 at selected plan centers. Bidders shall submit questions no later than 1:00 PM, June 29, 2004. Where a response or addendum from the City can not be obtained prior to the bid opening, it is understood that the Bidder has made provisions for a more costly method before submitting the bid. Where conflicts or omissions occur in Plans, Specifications, or other related Contract Documents (such as manufacturer's instructions, reference standards, and regulatory agencies and codes), Bidder shall assume more stringent requirements and verify with the City before beginning work.
