



REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The City of Shoreline is soliciting interest from consulting firms and individuals to provide design services in connection with the **Richmond Beach Overcrossing (167AOX) Bridge Replacement CIP Project**. This project will design a new concrete bridge to replace the existing timber structure using Federal Highway Bridge Replacement Program funding and local matching funds. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$1,250,000. Design is scheduled for 2003-4 and construction 2005-6 or earlier.

Evaluation Criteria and Submittal Requirements:

Pursuant to state and federal regulations, a qualifications-based selection process will be used to select a consultant. The following information and criteria will be used to evaluate and rank responses:

- Qualifications/Expertise of Firms on Team;
- Qualifications of Proposed Project Manager;
- Key Team Members Qualifications (Prime Consultant and Sub-Consultants);

- Firm's Project Management System (Prime Consultant Only);
- Project Delivery Approach;
- References/Past Performances (Prime Consultant Only).
