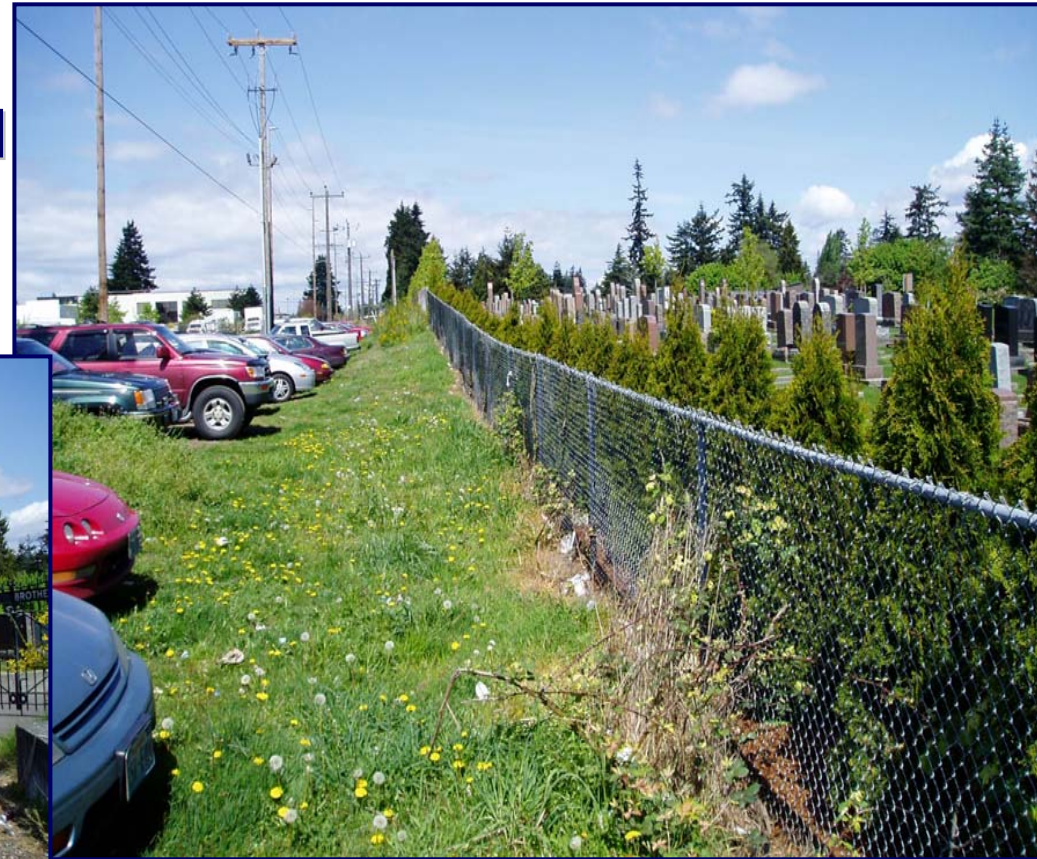

# Richmond Beach Saltwater Park Volunteer Planting Project

- On Oct. 16, volunteers planted dune grass, coastal strawberry, and shore pine to stabilize the slope and minimize erosion





# 3rd Avenue NW Drainage Improvement Project
