ORDINANCE NO. 288

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE CITY'S ZONING MAP TO CHANGE THE ZONING OF A PORTION OF A PROPERTY LOCATED AT 14516 12TH AVENUE NE FROM R-6 TO R-12.

WHEREAS, certain properties, located at 14516 12th Avenue NE, are designated on the Comprehensive Plan Map as Mixed Use; and

WHEREAS, owners of certain property, located at 14516 12th Avenue NE have filed an application to reclassify a portion of the property from R-6, residential – six units per acre to R-18, residential – eighteen units per acre; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2001, a public hearing on the application for reclassification of property was held before the Planning Commission for the City of Shoreline pursuant to notice as required by law; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2001, the Planning Commission recommended an alternate to the reclassification application to R-18 by recommending a reclassification to R-12 and entered findings of fact and a conclusion based thereon in support of that recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council does concur with the Findings and Recommendation of the Planning Commission, specifically that the reclassification of certain portion of property, located at 14516 12th Avenue NE to R-12 is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and appropriate for this site rather than the proposed R-18 zoning in the application;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Findings. The Findings and Recommendation on File No. 2001-201031 as set forth by the Planning Commission on September 20, 2001 and as attached hereto as Exhibit 1 are hereby adopted.
- Section 2. Amendment to Zoning Map. The official zoning map of the City of Shoreline, is hereby amended to change the zoning classification of certain portion of property, located at 14516 12th Avenue NE and further described and depicted in Exhibit 2 attached hereto, from R-6 to R-12.
- **Section 3.** Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or the application of a provision to any person or circumstance, is declared invalid, then the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected.
 - Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall go into effect five days after passage,

and publication of the title as a summary of this ordinance.
