ORDINANCE NO. 300

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 10.20.010 OF THE SHORELINE MUNICIPAL CODE BY LOWERING THE SPEED LIMIT ON 27TH AVENUE NORTHEAST FROM NORTHEAST 145TH STREET TO NORTHEAST 158TH STREET FROM 30 MILES PER HOUR TO 25 MILES PER HOUR

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by state law (RCW 46.61.415) to establish maximum speeds on City streets and those portions of state highways which pass through the City; and

WHEREAS, Shoreline Municipal Code Section 10.20.010 identifies certain City streets on which speeds of greater than 25 miles per hour are allowed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to delete the street segment of 27th Avenue Northeast from Northeast 145th Street to Northeast 158th Street from that list, and lower the speed limit to 25 miles per hour;

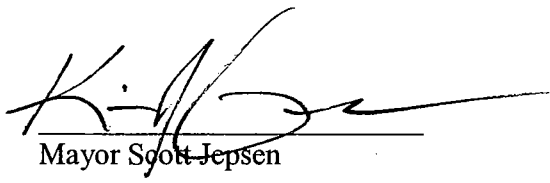
NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Shoreline Municipal Code Section 10.20.010, Speed Limits, is hereby amended by deleting "27th Avenue NE from the southerly city limits (NE 145th Street) to NE 158th Street" from the list of streets with a motor vehicle speed limit of 30 miles per hour.

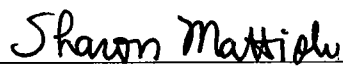
Section 2. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be preempted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. Effective Date and Publication. This ordinance, or a summary thereof, shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect five (5) days after the date of publication.

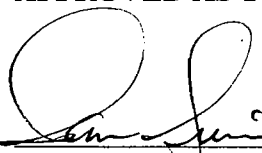
