EXECUTIVE / COUNCIL SUMMARY

The terms of four regular members and one alternate member of the Shoreline Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Advisory Committee will expire on March 31, 2003. The individuals who are being recommended by the Council's ad hoc committee, composed of Councilmembers Chang, Gustafson, and Ransom, have been informed so as to be ready to serve on the committee beginning at the March 27 meeting, if the Council confirms the appointments.

Notices of the vacancies and invitations for applications were advertised in the Shoreline Enterprise and the City's Internet Web site. Announcements of the position openings were made at the February Council of Neighborhoods meeting. The City received 12 applications. Councilmembers Chang, Gustafson, and Ransom reviewed all applications, interviewed selected applicants and will make formal recommendations to Council to fill the five positions at the March 24 meeting.

RECOMMENDATION

Appoint four regular members and one alternate member to the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Advisory Committee as recommended by the Council's ad hoc committee. The regular member positions will be four-year terms, and the alternate member position will be a two-year term.
