PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, on April 1, 2003 the City of Shoreline lost one of its foremost citizens when Judge Robert A. Wacker passed away; and
- WHEREAS, Judge Wacker graduated from the University of Washington Law School in 1964 and was elected to the District Court in 1975 after being in private practice and a prosecuting attorney; and
- WHEREAS, he served as Presiding Judge of the County's District Court in 1976 and 1977 and then became Judge of Shoreline District Court, where he touched countless lives in a positive manner, including marrying numerous Shoreline residents; and
- WHEREAS, Judge Wacker stayed at the district court level because he believed it was "the people's court" and an opportunity to influence how people felt about the justice system; and
- WHEREAS, Judge Wacker was very involved with youth sports, coaching the Bluestreaks Soccer Team, the Bob's Cats baseball team, and a Univac basketball team, as well as enjoying the sports activities of his four children, Paul, Ted, Doug and Tracie; and
- WHEREAS, Judge Wacker's kindness and fairness will be sorely missed by all those he came in contact with;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Jepsen, Mayor of the City of Shoreline, on behalf of the Shoreline City Council, do hereby proclaim the week of May 12, 2003 as a week in which to commemorate the life of
