PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

Each year since 1996 the Mayor has given a "State of the City" address in the first months of the new year.

The purpose of the "State of the City" is to give the community a sense of what the City has accomplished, where it currently stands and where it is headed in the future. The address celebrates the successes and challenges of the past year and provides an overview of what the coming year will bring for the City of Shoreline.

This year Mayor Hansen will present the address at the February 23 Regular Meeting of the City Council. Since City Council meetings are taped and broadcast weekly on Government Access Cable Channel 21, the State of the City will be available for viewing as part of the regular meeting broadcast. Council meetings are broadcast on Channel 21 Wednesday through Sunday at 6:00 a.m., noon and 8:00 p.m.

Like last year, the State of the City portion of the meeting will also be edited so it can be broadcast alone during special times over the following months. That schedule will be advertised on the government access channel and City of Shoreline Web site.
