**PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:**

The City Council authorized \$61,979 in the 2005 budget for the Shoreline Historical Museum to provide educational and cultural services in Shoreline such as museum exhibits, lectures, tours, and related programs; historic preservation research; traveling exhibits; and Hands-on Days.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

This contract was anticipated and included in the 2005 budget.

## INTRODUCTION

The City of Shoreline has contracted with the Shoreline Historical Museum since 1996. Funding is allocated in the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services 2005 budget.

## BACKGROUND

The Shoreline Historical Museum will provide the following heritage programs for City of Shoreline residents under this contract:

- Museum exhibits
- Lectures
- Tours and related programs

*Historic Preservation Research:* Services provided year-round for citizens and community groups.

*Traveling Exhibits - Outgoing:* Provide three different traveling exhibits, available to other museums, schools and/or other organizations.

*City of Shoreline 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Exhibit.* Dates to be determined.

The Museum facility will be open year-round, with typical hours being Tuesday through Saturday 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Archives open to public each Wednesday from 10:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Special tours and related research to be available by appointment. Unscheduled programming to include both outreach and site-based lectures and oral histories.
