INTRODUCTION

The City of Shoreline has contracted with the Shoreline Historical Museum since 1996. Funding is allocated in the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services 2005 budget.

BACKGROUND

The Shoreline Historical Museum will provide the following heritage programs for City of Shoreline residents under this contract:

- Museum exhibits
- Lectures
- Tours and related programs

Historic Preservation Research: Services provided year-round for citizens and community groups.

Traveling Exhibits - Outgoing: Provide three different traveling exhibits, available to other museums, schools and/or other organizations.

City of Shoreline 10th Anniversary Exhibit. Dates to be determined.

The Museum facility will be open year-round, with typical hours being Tuesday through Saturday 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Archives open to public each Wednesday from 10:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Special tours and related research to be available by appointment. Unscheduled programming to include both outreach and site-based lectures and oral histories.
