PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT

Council's Goal #8 calls for the City to develop a Healthy Cities Strategy and to update its Human Services Plan in 2009. The City Council is appointing a Task Force of Shoreline residents and stakeholders to assist with the development of this update.

The City solicited applications for this committee throughout the month of February and until March 10th. Articles were placed in Currents, on the City's Web Site and the announcement of the applications was widely circulated among the city's various communication lists. We paid particular attention to those involved in human services and neighborhoods.

A total of twenty-two individuals applied to be on the Human Services Strategy Task Force. One withdrew and one is a Lake Forest Park resident. Taken as a whole the applicants fairly represent the Shoreline community. Geographic representation includes citizens from nine neighborhoods of the city (see map attached). The applicants represent a diverse group based on race and ethnicity including nine individuals from communities of color. The age make up of the twenty under consideration: five (18-35yrs), five (36-55yrs) and nine (56-74yrs) with one applicant not reporting age. One applicant is disabled and served on the Human Services Advisory Committee in 2008.

The group has a broad range of experience with human services including both paid and volunteer staff. Five have direct experience working in non-profit organizations. Two applicants represent the faith community, one as clergy and one as a lay leader. Another applicant is on the King County Veterans Oversight Committee and one applicant is on the King County Human Services Levy Oversight Board. Two applicants were members of the original committee that crafted the current Shoreline Human Services Plan and five applicants have previously served on the Ad-hoc Human Services Allocation Committee. One applicant connects us with both the Shoreline School District and the Shoreline Community College Board.

Applicants describing neighborhood community involvement in their application include: one active in Highland Terrace Neighborhood Association, two active in Briarcrest Neighborhood Association, one active in Echo Lake Neighborhood Association and two active in Richmond Beach Neighborhood Association.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council appoint all of the eligible applicants to serve on the Human Services Strategy Task Force.
