**AGENDA TITLE:** Motion to Authorize the City Manager to Obligate \$1,000,000 in Washington State Public Works Board Urban Vitality Grant Funds for the Aurora Corridor Project, N 165<sup>th</sup> Street to N 185<sup>th</sup> Street

**PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:** Staff is requesting that Council authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement for the following grant funds:

- Washington State Public Works Board Urban Vitality Grant Funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the Aurora Corridor Project, N 165<sup>th</sup> Street to N 185<sup>th</sup> Street.

In accordance with the City's purchasing policies, Council authorization is required in order for staff to obligate grant funds exceeding \$50,000. Additionally, the Washington State Public Works Board (PWB) requires formal authorization of their contracts and supplements prior to execution.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

The Aurora Corridor Project (N 165<sup>th</sup> Street to N 205<sup>th</sup> Street) is identified in the City's 2010-2015 Capital Improvement Program. The following provides a summary of the funding sources for this project and the item under consideration is highlighted in bold.
