## PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

On February 25, 2008, Council approved authorization of the State Department of Ecology's Coordinated Prevention Grant that supported sustainable practices, such as the City's Earth Day, recycling events and green building features in the City Hall.

Similarly, the City will use its 2010/11 State Department of Ecology Coordinated Prevention Grant (CPG) funds to support the following:

- annual recycling events in the spring and fall of 2010 and 2011 for the collection of various recyclable materials, as well as bulky garbage and yard debris from residents to encourage waste reduction and to reduce litter in the right-of-way;
- ➤ one annual "Earth Day Every Day" event for residents in 2010 and 2011 that supports community sustainability by providing sample products, tools and ecoliving tips for the home and yard that will reduce solid waste and pollution, protect the climate, and save resident's money;
- Green Building program that uses the new City Hall as a model and includes workshops, tours and resource materials that assist residents and businesses with incorporating sustainable building techniques into their remodeling projects
- Climate Impact Evaluation to assist the City to define its carbon footprint.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

If the City executes the CPG Agreement, \$39,369 in 2010 and \$28,527 in 2011 will be provided as revenue to support the City's Environmental Services budget, assuming that the State's biennium 2011/12 budget is approved with the CPG funding. The 2010 Environmental Services budget approved by Shoreline City Council included the 2010 CPG revenue.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that Council authorize the City Manager to execute the 2010/11 State Department of Ecology Coordinated Prevention Grant Agreement for \$67,896.
