#### **PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:**

The City has recently completed its fifth citizen satisfaction survey (2002, 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2010). Beginning in 2002, the City has measured public perception about the City and its services by conducting a scientific survey of a random sampling of households in the City. In addition to measuring citizens' level of satisfaction with services, the survey helps determine priorities for the community as part of the City's ongoing strategic planning process.

The release of the survey results is timed to help inform the Council and staff prior to the 2011 budget review and adoption process. The results will be publicized on the City's website and through its monthly newsletter, *Currents*, as well as presented to various boards, commissions, and committees.

Ron Vine, Vice President of ETC Institute, who conducted the 2010 survey as well as the 2004, 2006 and 2008 surveys, will present the results of the survey at tonight's meeting.

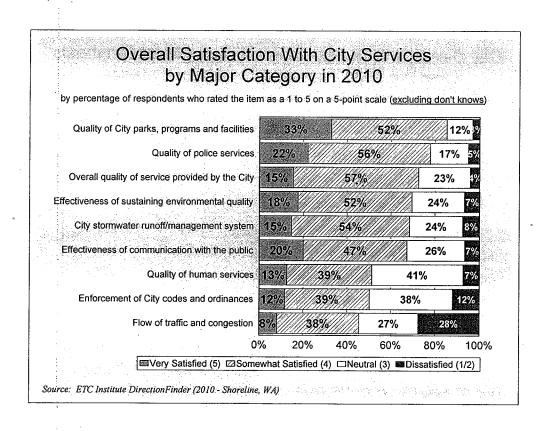
