PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

King County is currently in the process of redrawing the Council district boundaries through the Districting Committee (Committee) as required by law every 10 years. The Committee has proposed four options for redrawing district boundaries, and is taking public comment on the proposals. The Committee expects to present a final draft at its September meeting and finalize the plan at its October meeting.

The four options include two where Shoreline remains in District 1, and two options where Shoreline is split and becomes part of two districts. The Committee held a public hearing in Shoreline on June 29th, 2011, and the Committee members asked for Shoreline's opinion on the proposed drafts. Council will want to provide feedback to the Committee prior to its September meeting regarding whether to remain in one district or to be part of two districts.

Background:

The Committee is responsible for redrawing King County Council Districts using the new 2010 Census data. By law, district boundaries must be realigned every 10 years to reflect changes in population throughout the County. Redistricting is done to ensure that every resident of King County is represented fairly.

By law, the new district boundaries must be compact, contiguous, and composed of economic and geographic units. To the extent feasible, the districts must correspond with the boundaries of existing municipalities, election precincts, census tracts, recognized natural boundaries, and preserve communities of related and mutual interest. Population data may not be used for purposes of favoring or disfavoring any racial group or political party.

Three public hearings were held in May to gather community input. The Committee released four draft district plans in June and scheduled four additional public hearings. The Committee must approve a single final plan by January 15, 2012.

Drafts '2' and '4' keep Shoreline within District 1 and include the north end cities, including Lake Forest Park, Kenmore, and Bothell. These two drafts basically maintain the status quo, although the main difference is that Draft '2' does not include Woodinville, and Draft '4' includes all of Woodinville.

Drafts '1' and '3' split Shoreline down I-5 and Aurora Ave N, respectively and would place Shoreline in both District 1 and District 4 (on the west side).

Policy Discussion:

The outcome will be positive for Shoreline as there are positives for each alternative. Council needs to provide policy direction as to its preference for being all in one Council district, or being in two.

Below are a few positives and concerns for both options:

Remaining in one district (Drafts '2' and '4'): there were a number of speakers at the June 29th hearing that argued that Shoreline should remain in one district to keep the north end cities together based on our shared geography and regional issues.

- Positives keeps all of Shoreline in the same district and doesn't bifurcate the
 city; and remains in the same district as the other north end cities. These two
 options mean only having to deal with one Council office, including staff, to have
 our opinions represented. Shoreline remains the next largest city in the district
 behind Seattle.
- Concerns there is only one office to rely on at the County Council.

Joining two districts (Drafts '1' and '3'):

 Positives – increases Shoreline's influence on the County Council by having two representatives, yet still retains our connection to the other north end cities. Having two Congressional representatives has been beneficial to Shoreline at the Federal level.

Additionally, there are a number of cities that prefer to have more than one representative on the County Council, including Seattle, Bellevue and Redmond. The Committee Chair noted at the hearing that Woodinville sent a formal comment letter requesting to be in two Council districts.

Concerns – requires more staff time to coordinate with two Council offices.

There are two constants that remain under any of the plans; 1) that the district or districts will include large portion(s) of North Seattle; and 2) Shoreline will remain in a district with the other north end cities (except Draft '2' which excludes Woodinville). It has been staff's experience that elected representatives represent their city(s) regardless of the number of people represented from a given city.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff does not have a policy recommendation. This agenda item is for discussion purposes and for Council to provide staff direction in providing comments to the Districting Committee.






