INTRODUCTION

This evening the Council wishes to honor the service of four members of the Shoreline Planning Commission by recognizing their commitment and contribution.

BACKGROUND

The Shoreline Planning Commission is comprised of seven residents appointed by the City Council for the purpose of providing guidance to the Council on issues related to land use and long-range planning.

This evening the Council will honor four former members of the Shoreline Planning Commission: John Behrens, Janne Kaje, Michael Broili, and Ben Perkowski. Mr. Broili served seven years on the Planning Commission, and Mr. Behrens and Mr. Perkowski each served four years. We would also like to thank Mr. Kaje for his nearly four years on the Commission. Mr. Kaje resigned from the Commission in January because he moved outside of Shoreline.

The outgoing members have worked on a variety of planning related issues such as site-specific comprehensive land use map amendments and zoning changes and hundreds of Development Code and Comprehensive Plan text amendments. The four commissioners also participated in the update of the Transportation Master Plan, development of the mixed use zone regulations, Point Wells Subarea Plan, CRISTA and Washington State Public Health Lab Master Development Plans, development and implementation of the Ridgecrest Planned Area and both the Town Center and Southeast Neighborhoods Subarea Plans.

In addition to the regular twice a month meetings, the Commissioners attended many special meetings and served on several subcommittees – devoting literally hundreds of hours in service to the City.

The City Council should recognize and thank John Behrens, Janne Kaje, Michael Broili, and Ben Perkowski for their service on the Planning Commission.
