PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

The Celebrate Shoreline event celebrates Shoreline's incorporation as a city with activities that bring together citizens, community leaders, agencies and businesses. New to Celebrate Shoreline is DogFest sponsored by Shoredog at Hamlin Park on Saturday, August 11. Previously held at the Shoreview Dog Park, it has moved dates and location to become part of Celebrate Shoreline. The North City Jazz Walk will take place on Tuesday, August 14. There will be ten venues of jazz music and is sponsored by the North City Neighborhood Association, the North City Business Association and the Shoreline Arts Council. Then on Friday, August 17 will be the popular Sk8 Competition at the Connie King Skate Park. Saturday begins with the annual parade along 15th Ave NE followed by the community festival and car show at Ridgecrest Elementary. The celebration ends on Sunday, August 19 with the Sand Sculpture Contest beginning at noon. This event is sponsored by the Richmond Beach Community Association at Richmond Beach Saltwater Park.

Accepting the proclamation this evening will be Evan Voltsis, the 2012 Parade Marshal. Evan has been a vital business owner in the community for many years and has been a supporter of a variety of community events and programs including the Shoreline Public Schools Foundation, Shoreline Rotary Clubs, Shoreline Public Schools and the YMCA. He has contributed both financially and through donations of the delicious food from Spiro's. Evan is a lifelong resident of Shoreline and a graduate of Shorewood High School.
