At 5:20 p.m., the City Council met outside the City Hall entrance and then commenced a tour of various sites in the City to inspect sidewalks. Councilmember Hall did not attend the sidewalks tour.

At 6:25 p.m., Mayor McGlashan commenced the second portion of the Special Meeting in Conference Room 104.

The Council engaged in a brief discussion about the criteria for priority sidewalk construction and related issues such as accident data, traffic volumes, and grant funding. They discussed the list of priority sidewalk locations on 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Ashworth Avenue, 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue & Briarcrest, and the entrance to Richmond Beach Saltwater Park. There were opinions expressed about the prioritization process and whether recommendations should be provided by Council or by the staff.

There was a brief discussion about the street vacation request as well as cut-through traffic and other impacts on traffic circulation at N 145<sup>th</sup> Street in the Briarcrest neighborhood.

At 6:55 p.m., Mayor McGlashan declared the meeting adjourned.
