#### PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

Staff is requesting that Council authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with Doolittle Construction, LLC for the construction of the 2017 Bituminous Surface Treatment (BST) Project in the amount of \$447,337.86. This project is part of the Annual Road Surface Maintenance Program in the 2017-2022 Capital Improvement Plan.

## **BACKGROUND**

This project will apply Bituminous Surface Treatment (BST) on various local streets. This is part of the pavement preservation program that the City is implementing to maintain the pavement condition of the streets citywide. The application of BST typically occurs in odd numbered years (with street overlay happening in even numbered years). Attachment A to this staff report provides the streets included in the 2017 BST contract.

# **ALTERNATIVES ANALYZED**

Between April 12<sup>th</sup> and May 3<sup>rd</sup>, the City solicited bids for the construction of this project. The engineer's construction estimate was \$474,393. Two bids were received and opened on May 3, 2017. Doolittle Construction, LLC was the apparent low bidder. The two bids received were as follows:

Contractor Name	Bid Received
Doolittle Construction	\$447,338
Granite Construction	\$600,000

City staff has determined that Doolittle Construction has a responsive bid and that it has met contractor responsibility requirements. Construction is anticipated to start in July 2017 with completion anticipated in August 2017.
