PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

In 2020 and 2021 during the COVID-19 pandemic, National Night Out was not celebrated in Shoreline as it has been in past years. In 2022, the City is returning to organized in-person summer events and we will celebrate National Night Out for Community on August 2nd. Once again, residents can register their block parties and obtain permits to close streets. They can also request visits from City officials, staff, and Police and Fire Department representatives.

Recognizing the important roles neighbors have played in each other's lives during the pandemic, the City of Shoreline encourages residents to continue building stronger relationships with the people in closest proximity to them so they can create a more connected, resilient, and safer community.

WHEREAS, the City of Shoreline encourages residents to continue building stronger relationships with their neighbors to enhance community responsiveness, resilience, and safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shoreline provides tools and support to create stronger community connections;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Keith Scully, Mayor of the City of Shoreline, on behalf of the Shoreline City Council, do hereby proclaim August 2, 2022, as
