- WHEREAS, the Shorewood Girls' Swim team participated in the prelims and the finals of the Class 4A state swimming championships November 14-15 at King County Aquatic Center; and
- WHEREAS, the T-birds were represented by Leanne Dull, Jackie Benson, Laura Hill, Emily Maryatt, Monica Bernhard, Kelsey Wright and alternates Amber Buntin, Leah DePaoli, Jessica DePaoli, Emily Hoffmann, Kristine Young, and Erin Warness; and
