## PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

Demand at food banks is at an all time high and the holiday season will soon be here. A local organization, Hopelink, addresses this need in Shoreline and serves over 250 families per week at the Shoreline Food Bank. Larry Pauls, a local Realtor working with Preview Properties, has spearheaded a community food drive that will benefit Hopelink. He has engaged other businesses, churches, local Girl Scouts and other community organizations. Food is being collected weekends from November 1 through November 16 at various locations throughout Shoreline. The Shoreline Schools have made space available at the corner of 1<sup>st</sup> and 185<sup>th</sup> for a central drop off location.
