PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

The City Council has appointed an advisory Shoreline Library Board to oversee the services provided by the King County Library System (KCLS) at the Shoreline Library and Richmond Beach Library. The Shoreline Library Board meets six times a year to review local library activities and works with KCLS staff on ways to improve library services to residents of Shoreline. The Shoreline Library Board also advocates for additional funding and support for our local branches, frequently attending KCLS Board of Directors meetings and budget hearings.

Annually the Shoreline Library Board is scheduled to update the City Council on accomplishments in the past year, and provide an update on the Shoreline Library Board plans and goals for the upcoming year.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Annually \$2,000 is included in the Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Services Budget for Shoreline Library Board travel and training.
