PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

The American Red Cross is the nation's official disaster relief organization. Its foremost responsibility is to reduce human suffering nationwide. Locally, the Red Cross responds to help the victims of many single family and apartment fires, as well as those displaced by flooding, winter storms, and other events. To do this the Red Cross relies on hundreds of volunteers who donate thousands of hours of their time to help their neighbors.

In addition to disaster relief, the Red Cross provides training in health and safety, as well as disaster preparedness. Last year in King and Kitsap counties alone, 66,379 people received such training. Red Cross volunteers also provide emergency communication for members of the U.S. Armed Forces and their families.

The proclamation of "Red Cross Month" acknowledges the contributions of Red Cross volunteers to the quality of life in their community. Nan Barbo, a Shoreline resident and Red Cross volunteer, will be at the meeting to accept the proclamation.

- WHEREAS, the American Red Cross has been serving the people of Washington State for over one hundred years; and
