PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

In 1993 the Center for Human Services and the Shoreline/Northshore Public Health and Safety Network came together to develop a new cutting edge program to serve young families with children from birth to five. With funding from the King County Children and Families Commission the Center for Human Services opened the doors to the Shoreline Family Support Center in the spring of 1994.

The Shoreline Family Support Center provides services to over 1,000 families each year. The Center mission is to strengthen, empower and increase social support for all families. Their services include information, education, resources and referrals to families in need from many cultures and ethnic backgrounds. During a visit to the Family Support Center on any given afternoon and into the evening you would see the parents, grandparents and children engaged in English Language Learners (ELL) classes, citizenship classes, homework tutoring, parent support groups and family activities. In the current year, the City of Shoreline provides financial support to the Family Support Center as a part of it's overall funding for the Center for Human Services.

This year the Family Support Center is celebrating its ten-year anniversary as a focal point in the community for new and successful family programs. A representative from the Family Support Center will attend the Council meeting to accept the proclamation.
