#### **ISSUE STATEMENT:**

The City Council recently completed the annual performance evaluation of the City Manager according to the City Manager's contract executed April 17, 2001. The Council and City Manager use this review as an opportunity to define goals and objectives and professional development for the City Manager for the upcoming year, and to adjust salary and benefits based on city operations, and progress on the Council Work Plan and other performance objectives over the past year.

As a result of this evaluation the Council recommended base salary of Section 4 be increased to \$120,691 which reflects an adjustment of 1.4% over 2002 compensation. This is the same increase made to other city employee salaries for 2003. This increase is effective February 1, 2003.

The change to base salary (Section 4) is incorporated into the Second Amended Employment Agreement Between the City of Shoreline, Washington and Steven C. Burkett (Attachment A).

These changes will continue to maintain Mr. Burkett close to the median of total compensation for his peers in the Puget Sound region.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

This contract amendment will result in a base salary increase of \$1666. \$1527 of this increase along with an increase of \$213.80 in annual retirement benefit<sup>1</sup> will be paid in 2002. The 2003 budget for salaries and benefits in the City Manager's Office will increase by a total of \$1740.80. There is sufficient funding in the department's budget to cover this increase.
