PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

The purpose of this report is to inform the City Council and the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services (PRCS) Board of progress to date, engage the City Council and PRCS Board in discussion about the future of the PRCS Department facilities and services, and to identify issues and challenges.

BACKGROUND:

On May 12, City Council gave approval for the City Manager to execute a contract with GreenPlay LLC to complete the update of the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan (PROS Plan). The PROS Plan update work is underway.
