PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT:

City Council was provided the application materials of each of the Planning Commission applicants at the October 25, 2004 meeting. On November 1, 2004 the Council determined that all applicants would be interviewed, confirmed the questions that would be asked of each person, and formed a three member sub-committee of Mayor Hansen, and Council Members Gustafson and Grace to conduct the interviews. The interviews were held on November 18, 2004.

The Council will hear a report from the subcommittee at this meeting.

The purpose of this meeting is for Council to appoint the final candidate that will fill the current Planning Commission unexpired vacancy that resulted from a resignation. This term will expire on March 31, 2008. If appointed at the November 22, 2004 Council Meeting it is expected that the Commissioner would take office at the December 2, 2004 Regular Planning Commission Meeting.

RECOMMENDATION

The Council should make a motion to appoint a Planning Commissioner. After the vote, the Mayor will confirm the appointment.
