PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, August 1, 2006, has been declared the 23rd Annual National Night Out Against Crime by the National Association of Town Watch and is sponsored locally by the Shoreline Police and Shoreline Neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, National Night Out is designed to heighten crime prevention awareness, neighborhood sense of community and police-community partnerships and send a message to criminals that neighborhoods are organizing and fighting back against crime; and

WHEREAS, Residents are encouraged to join other communities across the nation in celebrating National Night Out by locking their doors, turning on their outside lights and spending the evening from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. outside with their neighbors and local police; and
