PROBLEM/ISSUE STATEMENT: The purpose of this staff report is to request Council's approval to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement to obligate grant funds totaling \$1,215, 000 from the Interagency for Outdoor Recreation (IAC) for the Interurban Trail North Central Section. The North Central Trail Section Project is located along the Seattle City Light (SCL) right of way between 175th Street to 192nd Street and is identified in the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

Council authorized staff to submit a grant application to the IAC for the subject section of the project at the June 28, 2004 meeting. In accordance with the City's grant procedures, Council approval to authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement is required in order to secure the grant funds. The IAC's funding capacity for this project cannot exceed 50% of the total project cost.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: Based on the 2006 -2011 CIP, the total amount estimated to construct the North Central Section of the project totals \$2,430,000. The following provides a summary of the project funding:
