At the City Council meeting of December 12, 2005 the City Council voted unanimously (see attached minute extract) to conduct a back ground check and personal and professional reference review for Mr. Mauer. On December 13 the City Attorney forwarded to Mr. Mauer the City's standard reference release form. Since then I have been in contact with Mr. Mauer regarding the ramifications and confidentiality associated with this release. On December 21 Mr. Mauer provided references and is scheduled to submit the final release form on Friday, December 23. As I indicated in a voice mail to Council earlier in the week, we have contracted with the firm of Prothman and Associates to conduct the independent reference check and back ground review. This back ground review is necessary before Mr. Mauer is hired as the City's interim City Manager or hired as a temporary employee to conduct the management assessment and City Manager recruitment. I will provide any additional updated information to the Council verbally on December 27nd.
