Re: Olympic View Water and Sewer District Comprehensive Plans Update and Amendments

Thank you for your timely response to our recent letter regarding the update our water comprehensive plan and amendment to our sewer comprehensive plan.

I would be glad to take comments on areas of water and sewer service, where our plans will have impacts on or be impacted by the City of Shoreline. I will discuss them with our engineers and then, when appropriate, we can get together and discuss how your issues can be addressed within the context of our Comprehensive Plans.

Olympic View has not been involved in any transition discussions regarding the assumption of Ronald Wastewater by the City of Shoreline. We would not have expected to be involved given the assumption is for that area within the Shoreline City Limits, according to the 2002 agreement with Ronald Wastewater. We have existing contracts that address both facility fees and wheeling fees, paid by Olympic View customers, to reimburse Ronald Wastewater for the use of their facilities. We have been assured that existing contracts will be honored.

I am aware that Ronald Wastewater District has facilities that serve City of Shoreline. Town of Woodway and Unincorporated Snohomish County, located both inside and outside of the City of Shoreline, as does the District. My records indicate that Woodway, Shoreline and Snohomish County area customers have shared equally in the costs of the capital, maintenance and repair of all District facilities regardless of location throughout the years.

As a result of the recent Boundary Review Board hearing decisions, it is not likely that Ronald Wastewater District will continue to exist to serve the area outside of King County after 2017. It is the District's responsibility to provide service to all customers

located within Olympic View District's corporate boundaries. The joint use of facilities located outside of the city is a topic that will need to be addressed in the future.

I look forward to receiving the referenced request regarding the discussion of utility service and any comments.
