RE: Second Access for Point Wells

Dear Mr. Faison:

I wanted to follow up on comments made under oath by you and your Town attorney Wayne Tanaka during Woodway's testimony at the proceedings before the Snohomish County Boundary Review Board on Thursday, August 28, 2014. Mr. Tanaka stated that the Town of Woodway could provide additional access routes to Point Wells through Woodway. In fact, during the testimony, you indicated on the map two potential access routes through Woodway.


I would like more information about these potential routes, the current status of the discussions with your Town Council about these routes, a map of the two potential routes and any documentation on the analysis that Woodway has completed on these routes.

As I have stated previously, Shoreline is interested in negotiating an Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Woodway regarding the potential future development at Point Wells. This Interlocal should recognize impacts on our jurisdictions and how to address those impacts for the long-term. It is important to understand the additional access routes and how this may impact potential traffic patterns and necessary mitigation for both the City of Shoreline and the Town of Woodway. As you are aware the City of Shoreline has engaged our residents in a Traffic Corridor Study to evaluate traffic impacts and to develop mitigation strategies to address these future impacts. Information on additional access routes can assist us in fully evaluating these strategies. Shoreline's EIS scoping comments included a request for Snohomish County to complete a special study to evaluate a second access to the east side of Point Wells to the Town of Woodway.

I look forward to receiving the requested documentation that demonstrates the two potential routes Woodway would consider for access to Point Wells, information on

the status of the route discussions with your Council and an opportunity to evaluate how these alternative routes may influence traffic patterns.
