Subject: Western Washington Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit G20. Non-compliance Notification for S5.C.5.a.ii Catch Basin Maintenance.

Dear Ms. Dettelbach:

As required in the 2013-2018 National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Western Washington Phase II Municipal Stormwater General Permit, *G20. Non-compliance Notification*, the City of Shoreline (City) is providing this written notification that the City is not in compliance with the maintenance schedule of catch basins required under *S5.C.5.a.ii Municipal Operations and Maintenance*.

Section 5.C.5.a.ii of the NPDES permit states: "Unless there are circumstances beyond the Permittee's control, when an inspection identifies an exceedance of the maintenance standard, maintenance shall be performed:

- Within 1 year for typical maintenance of facilities, except catch basins.
- Within 6 months for catch basins.
- Within 2 years for maintenance that requires capital construction of less than \$25,000."

The City is unable to meet the 6 month catch basin maintenance deadline due to timing differences between inspection dates and when the City can repair and rehabilitate identified catch basins.

The City does meet the intent of the permit because catch basins are scheduled for repair and rehabilitation. The City is working on improving the catch basin maintenance process with the goal of meeting the 6 month permit requirement within the next two years.
