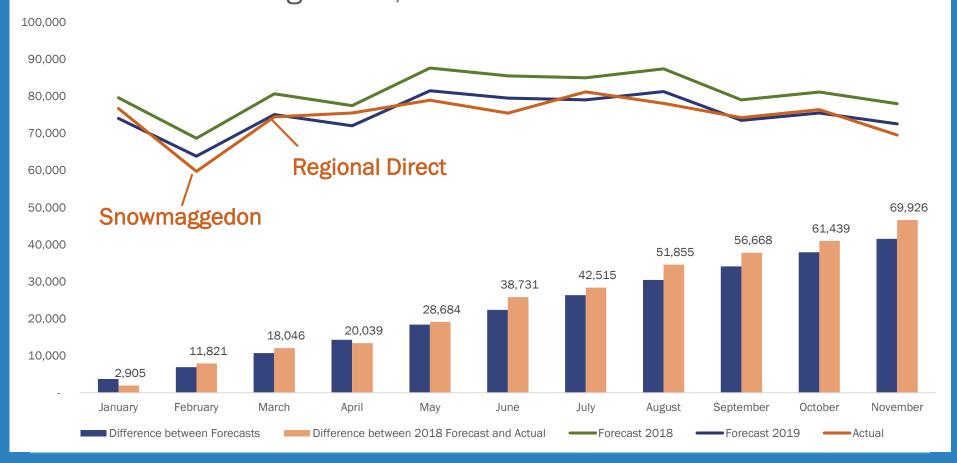

YTD Tonnage is 70,000 tons below 2018 Forecast

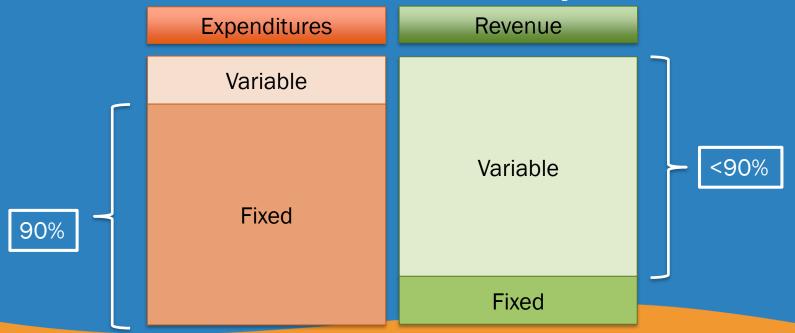
