A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation to set aside certain amounts provided under the BUILD program for rural areas, and for other purposes.

SEC. 2. SET-ASIDE FOR BUILD GRANT AMOUNTS.

2 (a) In General.—With respect to grant amounts provided under the heading "Office of the Secretary—Na-3 tional Infrastructure Investments" in title I of division H 4 5 of the Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020 (Public Law 116–94) for eligible projects, the Secretary 6 of Transportation shall ensure that not less than 30 per-7 8 cent of the amount provided under such heading shall be 9 provided to cities with populations of between 10,000 and 10 75,000, whether or not 1 or more of such cities are consid-11 ered part of an urbanized area as designated by the United States Census Bureau. 12 13 (b) ELIGIBLE PROJECT DEFINED.—In this section, the term "eligible project" means a project eligible for funding under title I of division H of the Further Consoli-15 16 dated Appropriations Act, 2020 (Public Law 116–94), including— 17 18 (1) a highway or bridge project eligible under 19 title 23, United States Code; 20 (2) a public transportation project eligible 21 under chapter 53 of title 49, United States Code; 22 (3) a passenger and freight rail transportation 23 project eligible under title 23 or title 49, United 24 States Code; 25 (4) a port infrastructure investment (including 26 inland port infrastructure and land ports of entry)
