I'm excited to share that the City of Shoreline has begun planning for pedestrian improvements in your neighborhood. This spring, our consultant team, KPFF, will begin designing a new sidewalk for 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE between NE 175<sup>th</sup> Street and NE 182<sup>nd</sup> Court.

These improvements are part of a voter-approved effort to build and repair sidewalks throughout the City. In the coming months, KPFF will develop a design for pedestrian facilities to serve 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE in the North City neighborhood and connect with existing pedestrian facilities in the area.

We are committed to developing a design that meets the community's needs. There will be opportunities for you to learn about and comment on this project at public gatherings later this year.
