On behalf of the City of Shoreline, I would like to thank you for the King County Council's adoption of a supplemental budget to address COVID-19 impacts. The Economic Development Relief Program, and specifically the funding allocated for economic development in cities, will help us take critical steps to support our local businesses. We share your belief that prioritizing support for local businesses is fundamental to getting through these challenging times. We have established an internal COVID-19 Business Response Team and, in collaboration with partners around the region and at the federal level, we are exploring every avenue possible to bring additional support to our community.
