
### Live Online Presentation with Q&A


**Project Description:** The City will be receiving \$2 million in Sound Transit Access Funds to spend on pedestrian improvements in the vicinity of the future Sound Transit "Shoreline South/148th Station" (light rail to open in 2024). Pedestrian improvements on 1st Avenue NE were identified as the top priority for these Access Funds. 1st Avenue NE will be a key access point to the light rail station connecting to/from the 145th Street corridor, the future 148th Street Non-Motorized Bridge (a pedestrian/bicycle bridge that will span I-5 at approximately 148th Street with direct access to the light rail station), and a bicycle network.
