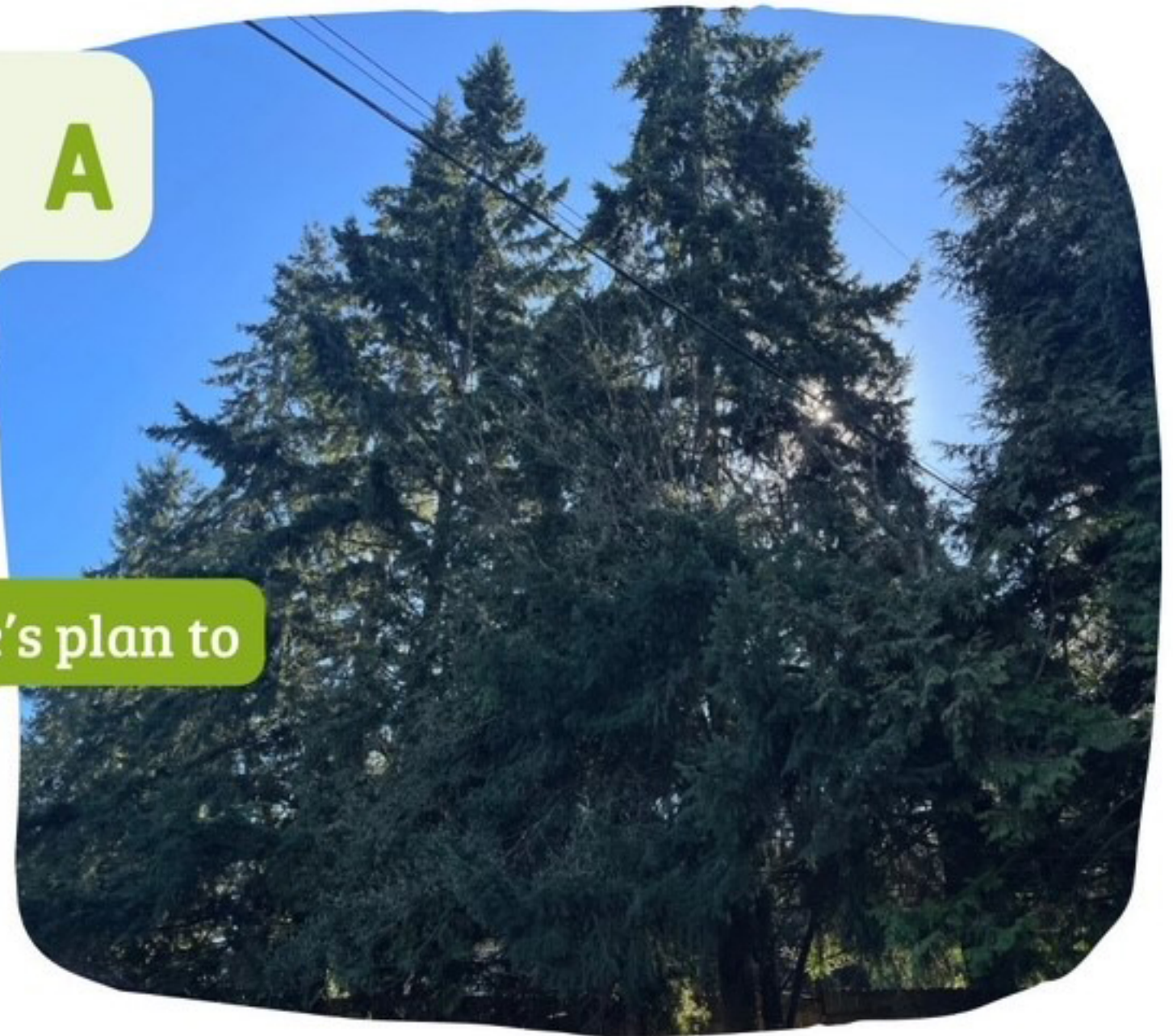

WHAT'S GOING ON?

- The City of Shoreline plans to remove 317 street trees next week to rebuild sidewalks
- They don't need to remove these trees, but it's cheaper to remove them than to thoughtfully build with them
- Street trees are important in making our city liveable: they **clean polluted air** and **fight against overheating**
- Shoreline plans to replace these big, native trees with smaller trees of species that will never provide the same benefits
- Building sidewalks around these trees will make our community safer and healthier for years to come
