<u>Highlights</u>

Our response times are down compared to January 2024 and the Year End Total for 2024.

Per Sgt. Ian Campbell: "1/4/2025 - C25000352: Big time team effort that started with K9 Deputy Planalp on viewing Sohaib Karany, a Rob 1 w/firearm warrant suspect, at the Polaris apartments. This turned into a barricaded situation where several resources were called in. Tac-30 initially declined. Warrant application had started with interior drone enroute from SeaTac. Ultimately, due to the fine work by Deputies to negotiate with the suspect/their family we were able to get a surrender in less than 2 hours. I entered a blue team commendation for all involved. We had a great debrief back at the station."

C25001439 – A male called 9-1-1 stating someone was trying to get into his apartment at St. Margaret's place. MPO Jackson attempted to contact the RP at the door and heard what sounded like a fight inside of the apartment and loud screams. The caller had cut his own throat with a kitchen knife. MPO Jackson made forced entry into the apartment where Shoreline fire was able to provide aid and transported him to the hospital for treatment and an involuntary mental health evaluation.

C25001424 (1/13/25), C25002633 (01/23/25), and C25003224 (1/28/25), Patrol arrested the same person out of the 820 N 145th St Complex. The person was stating the same thing that she was a tenant there and has rights. The management had the site secured with plywood and it was set for demolition. Subject was arrested during each encounter.
