Welfare Check Leads to Housing Placement



On July 10, 2025, at 14:01, Officers Alec Handley and Patricia West, along with MHPs John Streimikes and Emily Evans responded to a welfare check in District A3 near the south end of Echo Lake Park. They made contact with two unhoused individuals struggling with substance use disorder.

MHPs completed a recovery navigator referral and provided immediate resources. Through follow-up and coordination, both individuals were placed at the Aurora Oaks Enhanced Shelter, a high-performing facility offering private rooms and extended stays to support long-term recovery and transition into permanent supportive housing.

Stolen Gun Recovered 36 Years Later

A King County deputy took a handwritten report of a residential burglary in what is now Shoreline (District A6) on January 27, 1989. Among the items stolen was a Colt .45 pistol, valued at \$500 at the time.

In May 2025, 36 years later, the firearm was recovered in Snohomish County, still in good condition. The King County Sheriff's Office was notified, and a recovery report was completed and filed with the original case. The reporting party has since passed away.
