So here's where we're at with the chamber.

The important Creston part that we're waiting on is still due on May 23rd, but given supply chain it is hard to know if we can trust that date or not. Jessica and I will be thoroughly testing a temp solution in the next week and a half. And we'll have a full report out after that. We're pretty confident that we can arrange it so that council can return in person any date they choose, even before the part arrives, but there will just be some compromises in terms of what might be missing in the full hybrid experience.

But in the next week or two we can give a full report of what those compromises would look like if they were to return in person with the temp solution.
