Dear Mayor Winstead:

I am delighted to inform you that the **Firland Sanatorium/CRISTA Ministries Campus** at the 19303 Fremont Ave. N, Shoreline, has been listed in the Washington Heritage Register, where it joins over 1,500 other historic and culturally significant properties which have been recognized for their unique contributions to Washington's heritage. The Henry Administration Building/Martin Center and Detwiler Hospital/King's High School are historically significant as resources that are directly associated with the Firland Sanatorium, Seattle's municipal tuberculosis hospital and as the location/home to CRISTA ministries. The initial core of the buildings, including the two nominated properties opened in 1913. The hospital served at this location until 1947.

Having a property listed in the register is an honor. The benefits of State register listing include potential property tax deductions and code waivers to protect the integrity of the resource. Listing of a property does not impose federal or state restrictive covenants or easements nor will it result in a taking. However, listing in the Washington Heritage Register does assure protective review of a property should a federal or state action have a potential adverse effect to the property's historic values.
