

#### **ADDENDUM NO. 1**

### Right-of-Way Acquisition Services RFQ 4353

This Addendum No. 1, dated June 19, 2007 is hereby made part of the Request for Qualification Documents for:

City of Shoreline Right of Way Acquisition Services

The City of Shoreline has received several questions related to the Request for Proposals issued for right-of-way acquisition services for the Aurora Corridor Improvement Project (N 165<sup>th</sup> to North 205<sup>th</sup> Street). Following are the questions received and the responses.

Question #1 Are plans available indicating acquisition areas and property impacts
Answer: No

## Question #2 Is there a maximum number of pages for the RFP?

Answer: No. The only maximum number of pages are for those items listed in the RFP.

Question #3 Bullets 4 through 7 (4th page, under Submittal Requirements) do not indicate maximum number of pages. What are the maximum pages for bullets 4 through 7?

Answer: There is no maximum number of pages for the items for which no maximum is listed

Question #4 Does the City's approved right of way procedures include appraisal waiver limits of \$10,000.00 or \$25,000.00?

Answer: Right-of-way procedures have not been approved yet for this project.

# Question #5 Does double sided count as 1 page or 2 pages?

Answer: A double sided printed sheet counts as two pages.

Question #6 Are the relocations in the South Segment 165th to 185th or the North Segment 185th to 205th?

Answer: There may be relocations in the south segment and the north segment.

Question #7 Who the project manager will be on the Shoreline Phase 2 Project? Answer: Kirk McKinley and Kris Overleese will be the project managers for the Aurora Corridor Improvement Project (N 165<sup>th</sup> to North 205<sup>th</sup> Street).
