ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND
PETITION FOR REVIEW (Name of

This matter comes before the Board on the request of the petitioning community associations, property owners and residents referred to as "Save Richmond Beach" to amend their petition to correct the name of one of the petitioning organizations.¹ The Richmond Beach *Preservation* Association is incorrectly identified in the text of the petition as the Richmond Beach *Community* Association. Petitioners request leave to file an amended petition which corrects the error.


The Board notes that two settlement extensions have been granted in this case, and the prehearing conference has not yet been held. Although we are past the 30-day time when a
