### Meeting Summary

Meeting started at approximately 6:00 pm.

1. Welcome/Introductions Kirk

Kirk McKinley welcomed and thanked everyone for being there. Kirk introduced himself and ABC Team members and staff members introduce themselves.

Kirk reviewed the meeting agenda.

2. Cultural Resources/Stormwater Wrap up Kris

Kris opened the floor to team members for any thoughts or comments from the previous meeting discussion on Cultural Resources and Stormwater. The team and staff members discussed impacts to the red brick road, auto cabins, Echo Lake Tavern and Erickson House and requirements for the project to mitigate adverse impacts to these resources.

3. Environmental Analysis/Preliminary Findings/  
Process Update Jennifer

Kris reviewed the topics discussed by the ABC Team so far. Jennifer Barnes gave a Power Point presentation about the preliminary findings of the environmental analysis. She reviewed the environmental process to date, the preliminary results of the environmental analysis and the next project milestones. Team members and staff discussed specifics of the Air Quality analysis, the utilities and Public Services analysis, Noise analysis, and the Economics analysis.

Kris told ABC Team members that the public meeting to present the results of the environmental analysis will be held on June 20<sup>th</sup> at Meridian Park elementary school. She also told members that a ribbon cutting for the first mile of Aurora and the Interurban Trail bridges will be held on June 16<sup>th</sup>. Staff will send out reminders of these events to the ABC Team via email.

6. Project Alternatives – Challenges/Opportunities All
