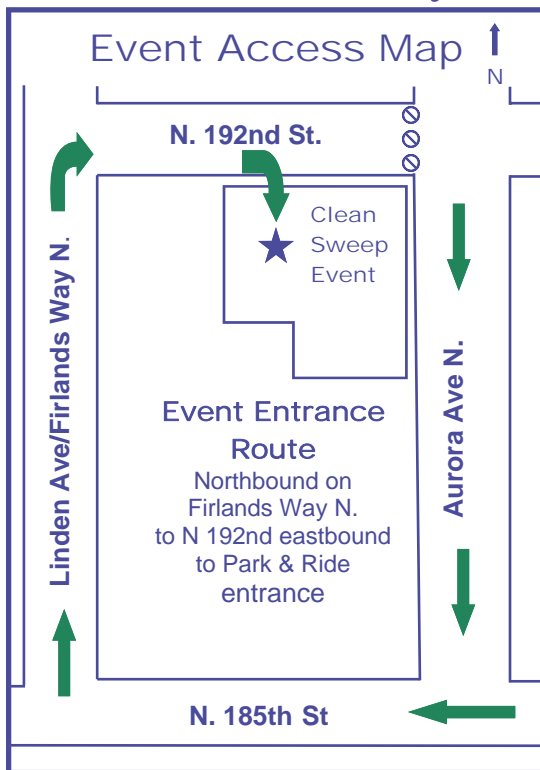

What to bring . . .

ALL APPLIANCES

Free, except refrigerators and freezers \$25 each. Water heaters \$5 each. *Cash only.*

BATTERIES

Used lead acid car, truck and marine batteries accepted, as well as used household batteries.



BULKY YARD WASTE

Item must be 3 inches to 2 feet in diameter, and up to 8 feet in length. Tree branches and stumps that cannot be recycled will be accepted. **No grass, dirt, rocks, sod, or garbage.**

CLEAN SCRAP LUMBER

No stained, painted or treated lumber. Pallet boards and nails O.K. No particle board.

E-WASTE: televisions, computer monitors, etc.

For a fee: Computer monitors \$10 each. Televisions encased in plastic or metal \$15 each. Televisions 37 inches or larger or wood consoles \$25 each. *Cash only.*

Free: Computers, phones, and associated equipment, such as mice, keyboards, printers, and adapters.



NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY TO EVENT

Due to legal changes in use of event funding, only residents who subscribe to curbside solid waste collection can attend the event at no cost.

Residents with curbside garbage collection need to **bring their new CleanScapes bill for entry.** Multi-family residents bring their driver's license.

Self-haulers need to pay \$6.75 for entry to the event. Cash only. Only \$20 bills and under accepted.

Event Tips:

Shoreline residents only.
One vehicle load only per household.
Keep children & pets inside vehicle.
We reserve the right to refuse any items.

FLUORESCENT LIGHT BULBS

No broken bulbs. Please handle carefully. Fluorescent light bulbs contain mercury, a toxic material, which is banned from landfills.



PORCELAIN TOILETS & SINKS

Recycle your old, water-guzzling toilets and sinks. Remove all non-porcelain hardware before recycling. \$5 each. *Cash only.*

MOTOR OIL, ANTIFREEZE & FILTERS

Kerosene, diesel fuel, lube oil, heating oil; and brake, transmission and steering fluids will also be accepted. Please **DO NOT** mix these fluids. **NO GASOLINE ACCEPTED.**



HOUSEHOLD GOODS & CLOTHING

Clothing and various household items in good condition will be accepted by Goodwill. **No mattresses, furniture, or items in need of repair.** Tax receipts are available.

PROPANE TANKS

All residential tanks collected. \$1 per gallon tank size. *Cash only.*

SCRAP METAL

Remove all non-metal materials from items.

NON-RECYCLABLE BULKY ITEMS

Items must be larger than 4 feet by 2 feet in size. Large items, such as couches and mattresses, that cannot be recycled or put in your curbside bin will be accepted. **No bags of small garbage items. No concrete.**
