- 2) Walk quickly, but don't run;
- 3) Use crosswalks, stop signs, traffic signals, school patrols, and adult crossing guards;
- 4) Walk on the left-side of the roadway, as far off the roadway as possible, facing the approaching traffic, if no walkways are provided.
